

The Maria Campbell/Bouchelle Scholarship for Children of Episcopal Clergy

Undergraduate Scholarship Application

The Maria Campbell/Bouchelle Scholarship Fund at the Community Foundation of Greater Birmingham provides scholarships for children of clergy of the Episcopal Church of the United States of America who are canonically resident in the Episcopal Diocese of Alabama. Two types of scholarships (undergraduate and graduate) are awarded annually, with preference given to applicants attending the University of the South.

Undergraduate Awards: Two \$20,000 scholarships are awarded annually. The scholarship is renewable for up to three (3) years after the initial award (\$5,000 per year for a total of 4 years). To be eligible for this scholarship, a student must be graduating high school in the Spring of 2024 and planning to attend college in the Fall of 2024.
